## **Conformity & certifications regarding SUPER TECH**

Juridic considerations:

The EUROPEAN NORMATIVE is very clear at this regard:

The Declaration of Conformity to CE normative must follow 8 basic modules (A - B - C - D - E - D - F - G - H) of which MODULE A (the one we have used) doesn't forecast the issue of the same, through an accreditation body. It instead forecasts the issue of a DECLARATION by the FABRICANT/PRODUCER, as it may be read through the DIRECTIVE 2004/108/EC.

Our SUPER TECH® must only stick to the requisites indicated on the above mentioned Directive, since it doesn't have electric compounds, nor electric connections that could bring to any sort of dangerousness.

The range of action of the electromagnetic field is very limited (maximum 10cm) as you may notice by using a detector of electromagnetic field, therefore it can, in no way, determine a fire, nor may it compromise the safe operation of the vehicle, since it doesn't have electric, nor mechanic, nor hydraulic connections with the parts of the engine.

It is our duty to properly underline that the DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY issued according to the up mentioned LAW, OBLIGES the Fabricant/Producer to:

The Declaration of Conformity must:

- immediately be put at disposal of the Authorities in charge of the control, if requested by them.;
- be kept for 10 years (unless otherwise disposed)

1. Stick to the controls of the competent authorities of the European Community.

2. Undersign a CIVIL RESPONSIBLE INSURANCE that we have regularly activated.

Your safety, therefore, stands on the CREDIBILITY of the ENTITIES of CONTROL of the same EUROPEAN COMMUNITY.

The Only NORMATIVE that regards our product is the mentioned 2004/108/EC that in case of products that:

"a) are incapable to generate or contribute to generate electromagnetic emissions higher than the compatible level with the regular functioning of the radio apparatus, of the apparatus of telecommunication or of other apparatus;"

Only in these cases, the Law FORECASTS that the DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY must be issued through a DECLARATION OF THE FABRICANT/PRODUCER (Module A)
